# Our Mission action Plan is see Christ Church through lens of a minster.

#### 1. Gathered and scattered

Minster was a community of people. Some are especially called to minister in worship, prayer and learning – to keep the fire burning. Others are called to serve through work-their primary front-line and minster prays for them, recognising this call as important as any other.

#### 2. Sanctuary and restoration.

The minster was a place of hospitality where guests might stay for shorter or longer periods and be refreshed. Healing teams. Prayer ministry.

#### 3. Sending and Calling (missional hub)

The minster serves the needs of other Christian groups in the surrounding community, *Sending* ministry teams to encourage and bless others.

The minster also *calls* to people -The minster operates as a training centre, providing both the building and vision for a shared ministry among colleagues. (Transforming Life; New Wine networks; Lion's Roar)

### 4. Gospel proclamation and Teaching

Historically the minster played an important role in the evangelisation of the neighbourhood. We call people into a relationship with Jesus Christ.



## Where do I fit into the Minster Vision?

<b>Gathered</b> I am especially called to 'keep the home-fire burning' – to be committed to the gathered Church, it's worship and prayer. To regularly intercede for its ministries and mission.
<b>Scattered</b> I see my place of work, community or family as where I can make the most difference. This is where I am most living-out my faith and putting into practice what it means to be a disciple of Jesus.
<b>Sanctuary</b> I am especially called to a ministry of welcome and hospitality, using my time, talents or home to reach out to those on the fringes, making safe space for them to both hear and be heard.
<b>Restoration</b> I am drawn to a ministry of healing/wholeness, counselling, enabling people to break free from controlling influences and experience the freedom and resilience promised by Jesus.
<b>Sending</b> I believe God has called me to serve Him in distinctive ministry beyond the immediate walls of Christ Church. I look to the church for practical and spiritual support as I do this.
<b>Calling</b> I am aware of my need for training and equipping to be stronger in faith and more effective in ministry; I need to go deeper in receiving God's love, healing and discovering His purpose in my life.
<b>Gospel-Sharing</b> I want to share the message of Jesus with others; develop new ways of reaching out; find others with a shared passion for evangelism; help others on their journey to faith.
<b>Teaching</b> I want to help others by word and example to better understand Gods word; I have insights I believe I am to share with others in different contexts.
